

## **Omaha and Lincoln Symphonies Perform on NET Radio's October "Nebraska Concerts"**

LINCOLN, Neb. (September 28, 2012) – The Omaha Symphony, Lincoln's Symphony Orchestra, the Nebraska Chamber Players, and the Nordic Choir all grace the stage for October's "Nebraska Concerts" heard Sundays at 1 p.m. CT on NET Radio.

October 7, The Omaha Symphony presents a program called "Power & Pipes," featuring organist Marie Rubis Bauer. The program starts off with Franz Schubert's "Death and the Maiden," continues with Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart's "Serenade #12 in C Minor, K. 388," and finishes with Joseph Rheinberger's "Concerto #2 for Organ and Orchestra, Op. 177." Resident conductor Ernest Richardson leads this concert for the symphony's chamber music series.

Next up, October 14, Lincoln's Symphony Orchestra's Edward Polochick and NET Radio's Lora Black present this concert based on NET Radio listener requests. Called "Classics by Request," this popular concert features music by Mozart, Brahms, Smetana, Tchaikovsky, Dukas, Hanson, Sibelius, and Elgar.

No concert is planned October 21 due to the NET Radio on-air pledge drive.

The last program this month, October 28, the Nebraska Chamber Players present Mozart's "Trio #1 in G Major, k. 496," Frank Proto's "Reflections," and Erno Dohnanyi's "Serenade, Op. 10." Also, on the program are songs sung by the Nordic Choir in a performance from the Abendmusik: Lincoln series. The Nordic Choir hails from Luther College in Decorah, Iowa and is led by Dr. Allen Hightower.

"Nebraska Concerts" is broadcast on NET Radio, a service of NET. Dave Hughes is producer; Genevieve Randall is scriptwriter and host.
