

## **“Downton Abbey Two” Marathon Starts Dec. 9; New Season in January**

If you are among the millions of fans of the popular PBS Series, “Downton Abbey”, which depicts the lives of the noble Crawley family and the staff who serve them at their Edwardian country house in 1912, enjoy the “Downton Abbey Season Two” marathon on Sundays in December on NET1/HD.

The popular series will be rebroadcast beginning Dec. 9 with parts 1, 2 and 3 at 7 p.m., 9 p.m. and 10 p.m. CT, repeating the following Saturday, Dec. 15, at 7 p.m., 9 p.m. and 10 p.m. CT.

On Sunday, Dec. 16, at 8 p.m. and 9 p.m. CT, watch parts 4 and 5, repeating Saturday, Dec. 22, at 8 p.m. and 9 p.m. CT. On Sunday, Dec. 23, at 8 p.m. CT, watch part 6, repeating Saturday, Dec. 29, at 8 p.m. CT. And on Sunday, Dec. 30, at 8 p.m. CT, watch the final episode, repeating Saturday, Jan. 5, at 8 p.m. CT.
