Advance notice of the public meeting was sent to Nebraska news media by means of a news release forwarded from the Commission office with Agenda posted in the NET Lobby and on the State and NET web sites. LB 898 (related to Open Meetings Act) is also posted in the NET Board Room on 1st floor.

Chair Ken Bird called meeting #453 to order at 9:40 a.m.

Following the call of the roll, it was determined that a duly constituted quorum of Commissioners to be present.

The Chair called for public comment. There was none.

The Chair requested approval of the minutes of meeting #452 as held on August 25, 2016. It was moved by Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Carpenter to approve minutes of meeting #452 as presented. Roll call vote was recorded as follows: voting aye: Commissioners Bird, Carpenter, Hadley, Kircher, May, Ohles, Ostrowicki, Smith; Opposed: None; Abstained: Gaswick: Absent: Schmailzl and Starman.

In the absence of AGM Randy Hansen, Roxanne McIntyre, Network Comptroller, reviewed the BKD LLP Independent Auditors Report for June 30, 2016. BKD performed the audit of the combined statements for the Nebraska Educational Telecommunications Commission, the Nebraska Educational Telecommunications Commission Facilities Corporation and the NET Foundation for Radio. The period included in the audit was the fiscal year ended June 30, 2016. It was moved by Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Ohles that the Commission accept and place on file the BKD report on the Commission's combined financial statements and related management letter for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2016. Roll call vote was recorded as follows: voting aye: Commissioners Bird, Carpenter Gaswick, Hadley, Kircher, May, Ohles, Ostrowicki and Smith; Opposed: None. Absent: Schmailzl and Starman.

Roxanne McIntyre presented the 1st quarter budget report for period ending September 30, 2016 for both the Television and Radio Divisions. The Finance Committee met prior to the meeting to review the report in greater detail. Motion was made by Commissioner Smith on behalf of the Finance Committee and seconded by Commissioner Ohles to approve the 1st quarter budget reports as presented and attached to the minutes. Roll call vote was recorded as follows: voting aye: Commissioners, Bird, Carpenter Gaswick, Hadley, Kircher, May, Ohles, Ostrowicki and Smith; Opposed: None. Absent: Schmailzl and Starman.

Roxanne McIntyre next presented the revised biennial budget submission of the modification list. It was necessary to revise the initial proposed modification list to include the possibility of self-funding salary increases and an increase in health insurance premiums. The balance increased from \$860,169 to \$1,027,696. The list and prioritization of the individual modifications did not change except for increasing certain existing modifications along with adding modification #2, UNTV production services of \$60,000. It was moved by Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Hadley to approve the revised Biennial Budget 8% Modification List for FY 2018 totaling \$826,325 for the current base budget and \$33,844 for FY 2018 new General Fund Request Issues. In addition, include \$167,527 to cover FY 2018 salary increases and an increase in health insurance premiums. Total modifications would be \$1,027,696. Roll call vote was recorded as follows: voting aye: Commissioners Bird, Carpenter Gaswick, Hadley, Kircher, May, Ohles, Ostrowicki and Smith; Opposed: None. Absent: Schmailzl and Starman.

The Chair requested a volunteer to serve as lay representative to America's Public Television Stations (APTS). Commissioner Kircher agreed to serve in this capacity. It was moved by Commissioner Hadley and seconded by Commissioner Smith to approve this appointment. Roll call vote was recorded as follows: voting aye: Commissioners Bird, Carpenter Gaswick, Hadley, Kircher, May, Ohles, Ostrowicki and Smith; Opposed: None. Absent: Schmailzl and Starman.

Chair Bird next appointed the following Commissioners to serve on the Nominating Committee: Commissioner Smith, as Chair with Commissioners Ostrowicki and Kircher as Committee members. The Committee will submit a slate of officers to be elected at the February, 2017 meeting. Commissioners are encouraged to contact Nominating Committee if they would like to serve as an officer and/or the Executive and Finance Committees.

AGM-Education Gary Targoff gave an update on education activities, including "After School Programs" in the Omaha area," Best of Enemies" and "Alzheimer's: Every Minute Counts".

AGM-Engineering Ling Sun reviewed activities related to reliability and quality of NET content. Work continues with OCIO (Office of Chief Information Officer) to improve this situation. NET Network is the State of Nebraska's primary relay system for the following: 1) Emergency Alert system; 2) Nebraska commercial broadcasters use NET radio as their primary EAS monitoring station; and, 3) NET TV initiates Amber Alert. The recent multicast stream outages raised concerns.

Ling Ling next reported on progress of the KYNE-TV relocation project. The cut-over timetable is projected for December 12, 2016 with tower at UNO dismantled May, 2017.

Ling Ling Sun was congratulated on her recent acquisition of U.S. citizenship. She indicated that she started this process in 2002 and it took 14 years.

AGM-Broadcast Production Rupert Macnee informed Commissioners of two recent major productions: *Medicine Woman* and *Paleo Sleuths*. Discussion followed regarding NET's involvement in a special program regarding the Vietnam War as a companion to Ken Burns 18 part series on *The Vietnam War* next September.

General Manager Leonard summarized a report in the absence of AGM Digital & Multimedia Chad Davis.

GM Leonard reviewed the Radio and Television Quarterly report submitted by Nancy Finken. The new "A Prairie Home Companion with Chris Thile" was launched October 15.

Secretary Leonard indicated that the APTS Public Media Summit will be held February 26-March 1, 2017 in Washington, DC.

He next reviewed the State and University budget situation. NET is to take the situation seriously with more attention given to the following three components: 1) positions/personnel; 2) travel; and, 3) equipment purchases. NET has the advantage of having some items as self-funded or grant-funded.

Strategic discussion involved ATSC 3.0 and NET's role in education.

The Chair called for new business.

Commissioners presented Dee Matulis with thank you gift for her support of Commissioners throughout the years.

Chair Ken Bird was congratulated on the honor of being crowned as the AkSarBen King for 2017.

The next NETC meeting is scheduled for February 16, a Videoconference Meeting originated at NET with sites at Omaha and Kearney. Following are dates for 2017:
